## **2. Exemption from Interview Examinations for Overseas Residents**

The Education Program of Mechanical Science and Technology and the Education Program of Environmental Engineering Science may exempt overseas residents from interview examinations if, having reviewed their application documents and interviewed them via the internet, the Programs deem them to possess particularly outstanding academic ability and be eligible for entry into the Master's Program. In the event that a candidate is exempted from an interview examination, that candidate shall be notified.
